

Idaho's Class of 2013: NAEP reading proficiency percentages improved steadily from the 4th grade to 8th grade to 12th grade, while NAEP mathematics proficiency percentages dropped steadily from the 4th grade to 8th grade to 12th grade.



Idaho's Class of 2013 - NAEP Results Reading and Mathematics 2005 - 2009 - 2013






The chart to the left illustrates how Idaho's Class of 2013 performed on the NAEP reading and mathematics assessments as 4th graders, 8th graders and as seniors in 2005, 2009, and 2013. Idaho is one of only 13 states that are able to report this data on the Class of 2013.

Sixty-nine (69) percent of Idaho's Class of 2013 were proficient in reading as 4th graders in 2005, 77 percent were proficient as 8th graders in 2009, and 80 percent were proficient in reading as seniors in 2013.

Eighty-six (86) percent of Idaho's Class of 2013 were proficient in mathematics as 4th graders in 2005, 78 percent were proficient as 8th graders in 2009, and 71 percent were proficient in reading as seniors in 2013.

Idaho's Class of 2013 is compared with their national public school peers for reading in the blue chart below, and for mathematics in the green chart.



Note: Students in the NAEP *Basic* Achievement Level and above are meeting or exceeding grade-level expectations, or *proficient in the subject*.
